José M. Miró MD PhD - Biography

Dr. José M. Miró is Senior Consultant of Infectious Diseases at the Hospital Clinic of Barcelona (Spain), Professor of Medicine at the University of Barcelona, Director of the MASTER on AIDS of the University of Barcelona and IDIBAPS Team Leader of Infectious Diseases and HIV/AIDS. He did a predoctoral stay at the Mayo Clinic, Rochester, MN (1993) and the PhD degree at the University of Barcelona (Spain) in 1994.

His research fields are focused on infective endocarditis and HIV/AIDS. In the endocarditis field, he is evaluating new antibiotics for the treatment of endocarditis caused by multi-drug resistant Gram-positive bacteria in the experimental endocarditis model and is doing epidemiological and prognostic studies with local, national (GAMES) and international (ICE, EuroEndo) cohorts. He is also conducting clinical trials on *Staphylococcus aureus* and Enterococcal endocarditis. In the HIV/AIDS field, Dr Miro is conducting cohort (PISCIS, ART-CC, RESPOND) studies, studies on opportunistic infections (including COVID-19), clinical trials in tuberculosis (TBTC, EDCTP), primary HIV infections and advanced late presenters and solid organ transplantation in HIV-1 infection.

He has published more than 850 articles in peer-review journals. He was HIV/AIDS Editor of the Spanish Journal of Infectious Diseases and Clinical Microbiology (2002-14). He was President of the following Societies: The Spanish GESIDA (1998-99), the Catalonian (2005-06) and the Spanish (2013-15) societies of Infectious Diseases and Clinical Microbiology and Dr Miro is the current President of the International Society of Cardiovascular Infectious Diseases (ISCVID, since 2019). Dr. Miro is member of the American (AHA) and European (ESC) Societies of Cardiology panels for the guidelines of prevention and treatment of infective endocarditis. Dr. Miro organized of the ISCVID Symposium of 2001 (Sitges, Spain) and is organizing the 2022 ISCVID Symposium that will take place in Barcelona (Spain) in June 18-20, 2022
